Repair and improvement project

Final preparations are being made for the drawdown of grant funding from the Community Ownership Fund and the Football Foundation (Premier League Stadium Fund). This will enable the Frome Town Community Benefit Society (CBS) to let contracts to deliver the repair and improvement project. The main packages of work are:

- New changing rooms, medical room & Clubhouse roof renovations (GD Carpentry Solutions Limited, Frome)
- Design and installation of plumbing and heating works supporting new changing rooms and Clubhouse (Aura Plumbing, Westbury)

Work is expected to start by the end of November.

CBS AGM

The CBS AGM is scheduled for Tuesday 10 December at 7 p.m. and will be taking place at Frome Town Hall. This is an opportunity for new Board members to come forward and strengthen the resources of the CBS. Previously, only those who had been members for 6 months or more were entitled to stand for election. Candidates need only to have been members for 2 weeks before the AGM under new rules. Membership will be free for a further 12 months for those that are already members. Applications to become a Board member can be submitted now and at any time up to and including Monday 2 December.
