Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 as amended and after giving notice to the Chief Officer of Police, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order will come into operation on the **22nd November 2024** and will remain in force between the hours of **16:00** and **21:00**.


All vehicular traffic will be prohibited from using the following roads;

Bath Street, Eagle Lane, Gentle Street, Palmer Street, Stoney Street, Catherine Hill, Cork Street, Market Place (bottom of Bath Street to The Bridge), King Street and Church Street.

- 2. The restrictions will apply when indicated by traffic signs.
- 3. Except as provided in Article 4 of this Order no person will cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or wait along the lengths of road specified in Article 1 of this Order.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order will apply to:
- (i) Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform
- (ii) Police, Fire and Ambulance emergency service vehicles
- (iii) Vehicles falling within regulation 3(1), 3(2), 3(3) and 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations
- (iv) Motor vehicles when being used in connection with the event stated above

This Order may be cited as Frome Christmas Light Switch-on.
